What is the overall <u>deductible</u> ?	\$750 individual/\$1,500 family in-network. \$1,500 individual/\$3,000 family out-of-network.	Generally, you must pay all of the costs from <u>providers</u> up to the <u>deductible</u> amount before this <u>plan</u> begins to pay. If you have other family members on the <u>plan</u> , each family member must meet their own individual <u>deductible</u> until the total amount of <u>deductible</u> expenses paid by all family members meets the overall family <u>deductible</u> .
Are there services covered before you meet your <u>deductible?</u>	Yes. In-network preventive services, outpatient hospital services, inpatient hospital services, most physician services, some pediatric dental services and drugs are covered before you meet your <u>deductible</u> .	This <u>plan</u> covers some items and services even if you haven't yet met the <u>deductible</u> amount. But a <u>copayment</u> or <u>coinsurance</u> may apply. The <u>out-of-pocket limit</u> is the most you could pay in a year for covered services. What is not included in the <u>out-of-pocket limit</u> ?	All out-of-network cost sharing amounts (deductibles, copays and coinsurance) except out-of-network mental health disorders & substance abuse medical emergency services; except out-of-network medical emergency services and out-of-network air ambulance services; premiums, balance-billed charges and healthcare this plan doesn't cover. Does this plan provide Minimum Essential Coverage? Yes
